### Reconciling biodiversity conservation and the economic development of local communities

The project aims to develop sustainable value chains for the benefit of communities living on the outskirts of Protected Areas in Ghana, to contribute to the conservation of threatened ecosystems.

### The change we pursue:

- 1. Contribute to the development of pro-biodiversity value chains** around five protected areas: organic shea butter, honey and beeswax, organic baobab powder and oil, organic virgin coconut oil, cassava and organic cocoa.
- 2. Improve community efforts to protect biodiversity and to sustainably use natural resources** through the establishment and strengthening of community-based governance structures (Community Resource Management Areas - CREMAs).
- 3. Strengthen civil society actors**, generate knowledge and share best practices to help address current and future challenges of biodiversity conservation and economic development.

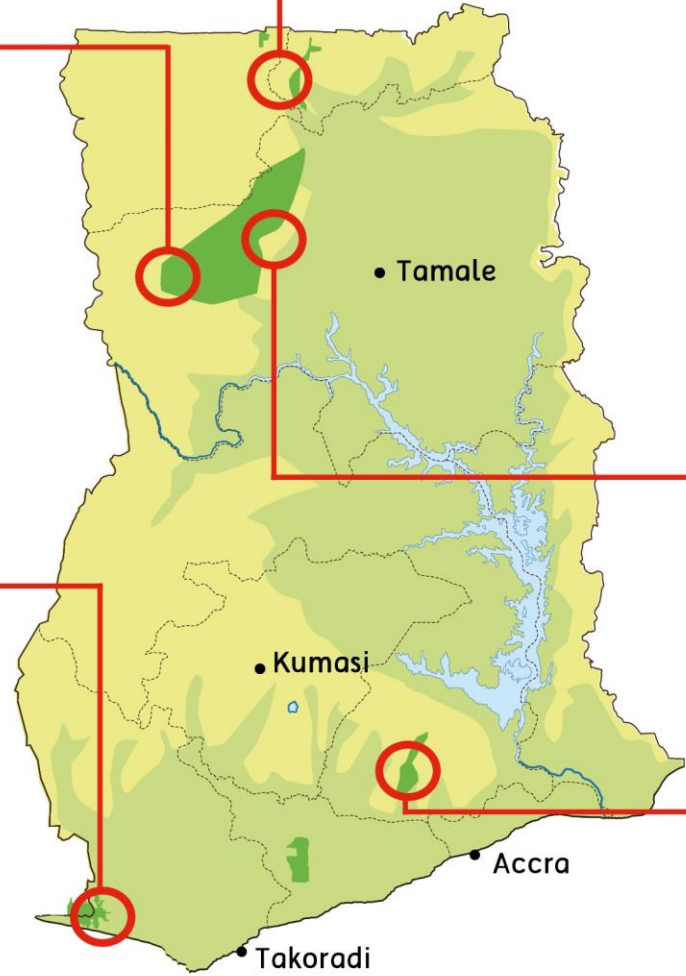
